¹Entering MAcc students must demonstrate competency in seven prerequisite courses in order to complete the MAcc in 40 credit hours. Students may be admitted to the program before the prerequisites are met. In this case, students take the prerequisite courses as they complete the MAcc program and the student's degree plan may range from 40-68 credit hours.

Students may demonstrate competency in the 7 prerequisite courses in the following manner:

Students with an undergraduate degree in accounting from an AACSB school	Earned a B- or better in the ACTG courses or by passing an on-campus exam; Earned a passing grade in Introductory Finance, Introductory Statistics, and Business, Accounting or Technical Communications ² or by passing an on-campus exam.
Students with a non-accounting (or non-AACSB accounting) undergraduate degree	Passing an on-campus exam for the ACTG courses; Earned a passing grade in Introductory Finance, Introductory Statistics, and Business, Accounting or Technical Communications ² or by passing an on-campus exam.

²The Business, Accounting or Technical Communication course must be taught in English. Course may be satisfied with BUS 3000 or ACTG 3069.

For detailed academic policy information, refer to Graduate Student Handbook. An overall GPA of 3.0 and an accounting GPA of 3.0 are required for graduation. Electives must be graduate (4XXX-level) courses.
